Joshua Langholf Memorial Scholarship

The scholarship will be awarded as two (2) separate \$250 checks, one in the fall semester and one in the spring semester, once the student has met the necessary requirements outlined below. The scholarship will be awarded at the Dakota High School Awards banquet.

ELIGIBILITY

The student must:

- 1. Have graduated from Dakota HS with a minimum GPA of 3.0
- 2. Maintain full time enrollment status of 12 credits, both semesters
- 3. Maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA, both semesters
- 4. Send the following items to scholarship committee each semester, prior to receiving \$250 check:
 - a. Class schedule for upcoming semester, proving upcoming enrollment
 - b. Unofficial transcript at the end of each semester, proving 3.0 GPA

SELECTION COMMITTEE

A committee made up of Joshua Langholf's family members will decide who the recipient will be. The committee's decision will be based solely upon the student's need and achievement without regard to the student's race, color, national origin, religion, sex, age, marital status, or handicap. A personal interview may be required.
