In March, the Technology Department used grant funds to purchase touchscreen Chromebooks for several additional grade levels of students. These devices are expected to arrive by the end of the school year and will be issued to students for the upcoming school year. In the Jr/Sr High School we are currently working to add a display to the inside concession stand. This will allow for easy viewing of games in the gym for the concession stand workers and patrons. This is expected to be complete by the end of the school year. We are also planning Chromebook checks at the Jr/Sr High School to be completed in April so we can verify proper functionality of those devices and repair any ongoing issues that have yet to be reported. Over Spring Break, we reconfigured the phone system for future expansion. We are also about to kick off a project with our phone vendor to verify e911 compliance for correct location sending based on the size of our buildings. As we look toward the summer, we are finalizing our summer projects and are looking forward to doing some upgrades and updates to systems to provide the best tech experience for our students and staff.
