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#### **Maintenance Update**

The district completed plumbing work in hopes to improve our water quality. We replaced several faucets and drinking fountains in both buildings as well as replaced various plumbing hardware. We are scheduled to do a water quality test in October. The district also collaborated with the village to have a shutoff valve installed so that we will be able to turn off water supply to the older part of the elementary building to allow for maintenance or repairs.

As you drive up towards the elementary building, you may have noticed the riprap we installed just off the horseshoe in the elementary parking lot. We hope this will help with erosion issues we were experiencing there.
