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#### **Technology**

The technology department added Max Gibson as a technician this year and with his help we have completed over 500 work tickets in the first two months of school. These tickets range from a website unblock request to larger projects such as the installation of a new server for printing.

During the school year we plan on continuing to replace aging equipment which includes analog security cameras and some of the district servers. When possible, we engage students to assist on smaller projects, for example, the teardown and recycling of old and broken student and staff devices.

We have also been working on updating the district website which we anticipate will be released late October or early November. In addition, there is a new web-based rental system for school district facilities that we plan to release within the next several months.
